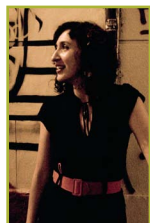
GURRUMUL - Blind from birth, Geoffrey Gurrumul Yunupingu is a quiet but deep well of musical creativity and expression. A former member of Yothu Yindi and now with Saltwater Band, Gurrumul's solo live excursions highlight his natural talent as a singer, songwriter and well respected multi-instrumentalist.

Gurrumul writes and performs songs in an almost "classical music" setting with just an acoustic guitar, grand piano, violin and double bass accompanying him.

Gurrumul was recently awarded Male Musician of the Year at the second annual Northern Territory Indigenous Music Awards, and his debut CD Gurrumul has been called by the Sydney Morning Herald "the most beautiful recording ever made by an Aboriginal musician."



LIOR - Lior was a highlight at the 2008 Southbound and is a very welcome addition to the headline acts at the 2009 Nannup Music Festival. His live shows appeal with his laid-back charm and charisma. Lior is a musician whose music gives more than it takes, offering a spiritually enriching experience for all involved and a reminder of a time when the music came first, and everything else was secondary.



MAMA KIN - Mama Kin delivers a raw and rootsy mix of blues, soul, country and reggae. "Mama Kin, has a voice that belongs somewhere back in the 1960s, in the sense that it is full, smoky and rich in tone. Playing on stage with her brother Michael Caruana she is captivating, entertaining and extremely talented. With her newly released EP "Papoose" and recently home from festival and club dates in Europe and America, Mama Kin is burning to bring her sound back to her country. This is a new talent not to be missed.



MICHELLE SHOCKED - Fiercely independent and versatile, she is an incredibly prolific singer-song writer who refuses to be categorized. Her music and performances are influenced by her Texas roots, her political activism, and a self-assured style. She has been likened to troubadours such as Joni Mitchell, Bob Dylan, Bruce Springsteen, and Woodie Guthrie, yet can swing, rock, and even melt your heart like no other. JEZ LOWE AND KATE BRAMLEY - A highlight of the international folk scene is Jez Lowe and Kate Bramley. County Durham singer-songwriter Jez and fiddle player Kate are coming to Nannup direct from the UK. Jez has toured the world for over 20 years and in that time has built up a formidable reputation with his songs amongst the most widely sung by folksingers and bands in the festival scene. Top of the line song writing with brilliant instrumentals and tight harmonies.

TIN PAN ORANGE - Jesse and Emily Lubitz with band form Tin Pan Orange, who have just released their second album "Death, Love and Buildings". This new album features the voice of Renee Geyer and was picked up with gusto by the folks at Triple J. This new and exciting band have performed throughout Australia including the 2008 Fairbridge Festival where they took the audience by storm.
