## INTRODUCTION

Now in its 21st year the Nannup Music Festival can rightfully claim to be one of the biggest and most important festivals on the West Australian music calendar. 2009 marked a significant mile stone with its first ever sell out and 2010 is expected to follow suit with an amazing line up headed by two of Australia's most loved musicians, John Butler (solo) and Harry James Angus. They will be joined by a stream of amazing artists from around the globe, all converging on the beautiful town of Nannup. ### JOHN BUTLER (SOLO)

Having sold out shows worldwide both in solo mode and with his trio, John Butler is one of Australia's most highly respected truly independent artists. He's also been recognised both on home turf and internationally for his highly acclaimed and multi platinum albums. The multiple ARIA and APRA Award winning song writer is about to launch a new journey with his brand new trio as they complete the recording of their fifth studio album 'April Uprising' due out in early 2010. John Butler will reflect on past tunes and share some new music with fans at the Nannup Festival when he performs in solo mode which is always a real treat for fans!

### HARRY JAMES ANGUS

While music has always been a major part of Harry's life it really took hold when he took up the trumpet, his second choice of instrument in high school. He has performed in many bands since then including Australia's much loved The Cat Empire. The next few years saw a lot of touring, multi platinum records, Aria awards, number one debuts and frequent flyer points. Harry has become renowned for his unique vocal abilities and wild stage presence.

### TIJUANA CARTEL

If Carlos Santana had been hanging out in Iraq for the last 10 years then he would have to sound something like the Gold Coast's own Tijuana Cartel. Their performances are a concoction of multi-layered grooves, splashes of Middle Eastern vocals, Electronic world beats and live Latin Cuban Percussion. In short, a fusion of world music and phat electronic beats. With recent stand out performances at the Woodford Festival and being labeled a buzz band of the recent Byron Bay East Coast Blues Festival, Tijuana Cartel's high vibrational dance music is uplifting audiences both nationally and internationally and will be a highlight at the Nannup Music Festival.

### THE YABU BAND

Multi-talented brothers Delson and Boyd Stokes have created a powerful and unique sound aptly described as Desert Rock/Reggae. Originally from Kalgoorlie Yabu is more than just an Indigenous band; they provide a message through song that inspires children through to adults to achieve all they can. Apart from the passion and charm lead singer Delson Stokes Jnr is a natural performer with an incredibly pure voice which is emphatically complemented by the blistering commentary of his shy, self-effacing brother's guitar playing.

### TIN PAN ORANGE

Melbourne folk pop outfit Tinpan Orange have been quietly spinning their alluring web of gypsy-infused acoustic longing since the intoxicating sound of Alex Burkoy's violin woke song writing siblings Jesse and Emily Lubitz one New Year's Eve. The band is currently touring their new LP "The Bottom Of The Lake", produced by Harry Angus (The Cat Empire, Jackson Jackson). Tin Pan Orange were a highlight of the 2009 Nannup festival and are welcomed back with great pleasure.

### JORDIE LANE

Jordie Lane makes his first appearance at Nannup with his unique finger-style guitar picking, blues harmonica, and a heart-breaking voice. Jordie and his star-studded band play his folk country songs with raw energy and passion for story telling.

### ELEANOR MCEVOY

Eleanor McEvoy is one of Irelands leading female singer/songwriters. Respected as a fine multi-instrumentalist in both traditional and contemporary music, she is best known for writing "Only A Woman's Heart", the title track of an anthology album that's gone on to be the best selling recording in Irish History. Eleanor's strong Irish accent adds to her renditions of her quirky, perceptive songs, ranging from love ballads and story-telling to left-of-centre takes on the vagaries of life.
